PRACTICAL INFORMATION



1. GENERAL INFORMATION

The XIII CLOROSUR Technical Seminar Safety & Sustainability Workshop Table - Top EXPO 2024 will be held from October 20 to October 23, 2024 in the city of Lima, in Peru.

The event will be held at the **HILTON LIMA MIRAFLORES HOTEL**, located at Av. la Paz 1099, Lima, Peru.

The event will take place on the second floor of the hotel, in the **Huascarán** room and the **Alpamayo room**.



2. REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY INTO THE COUNTRY

Foreign participants are required to present a valid passport with at least six months of validity remaining or an identity card (just for people from countries that belong to the Andean Community or Mercosur).

Please consult the website of the Peruvian Embassy in your country for more information on visa requirements.



3. VACCINATIONS

No mandatory vaccinations are required to enter Peru. However, it is recommended to have the COVID-19 vaccines up to date.



4. FLIGHTS AND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

a) LIMA AIRPORT

Jorge Chávez International Airport is located in the Province of Callao, 10 kilometers from downtown Lima and 24.2 kilometers from the event's venue.

The approximate distance between the airport and the hotel is one of roughly 15 to 18 kilometers, which can take 40 minutes by cab.



5. URBAN TRANSPORTATION SERVICE

For transfers in the city of Lima, we suggest using cab or taxi companies duly registered by the Hotel, or otherwise, hire one of the following cab companies that we suggest below.

The most widely used cab apps in Lima are Uber and Cabify.

It is not recommended to use street cabs.



6. LANGUAGE

Spanish is the official language in Peru, but many people in the tourism sector speak English.



7. CLIMATE

Lima has a subtropical desert climate. October is spring in Peru and much of the country will still be in the dry season.

Peru's coastline near Lima averages highs of 68°F (20°C) and lows of 59°F (15°C).

8. CURRENCY

The official currency in Peru is the Sol (S/ or PEN). It is issued in bills of 10, 20, 50, 100 and 200 soles, as well as in coins of 10, 20 and 50 cents and in 1, 2 and 5 soles.

In shopping malls and the main avenues there are cash dispensers (ATMs) and Foreign Exchange bureaus. However, U.S. dollars are an accepted currency in commercial establishments.

The most widely accepted credit cards are: VISA, Master Card, American Express, and Dinners.



9. ELECTRIC CURRENT

Electricity in Peru has the standard voltage of 220 Volts (AC), 60Hz and the outlets used are of the American type with two and three pins.





While in most hotels the outlets are set up to accept both types of plugs, it may be a good idea to carry an adapter.



There are a limited number of power sockets in the meeting rooms. In general it will only be possible to charge electronic devices in designated areas.



10. BUSINESS HOURS

Commercial stores are generally open from 10:00 am to 10:00 pm.

Banks	Saturdays from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm.	
Foreign Exchange Bureau	Foreign Exchange bureaus are usually open from 9:00 am to 7:00 pm.	
Shops and stores	In Peru, supermarkets and stores are open from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm. Shopping malls are usually open from 10:00 am and it is not usual for stores to close at noon.	
Coffee bars, bakeries and pizzerias	The main coffee bars, pastry shops and pizzerias are open from 7:00 am to 10:00 pm (They also offer delivery service).	
Restaurants	Lunch is generally served from noon to 3:00 pm and dinner from 7:00 pm. Some fast-food establishments are open throughout the day.

12. INTERESTING INFORMATION ABOUT THE COUNTRY AND CITY WHERE THE EVENT WILL TAKE PLACE

a) COUNTRY: PERU

Peru is located in South America and has an area of 1,285,216 km2 and an estimated population of 31.4 million inhabitants, with Lima being the capital city. The country is made up of 25 regions and the province of Lima. To the north Peru is bordered by Colombia and Ecuador, to the east by Brazil and Bolivia, to the south by Chile and to the west by the Pacific Ocean.

b) CITY: LIMA

The city of Lima is located on the central west coast of Peru and covers an area of 2,672.3 km².

Lima has preserved its past and achieves a perfect balance between tradition and contemporary architecture. When you are walking along its streets you can admire its churches, archaeological sites and mansions with balconies that exist side by side with modern buildings. In 1991, its Historic Center was declared a World Cultural Heritage Site.





Lima is also the only South American capital with access to the sea. Its beaches are perfect for surfers and on its boardwalks, the gentle breeze ensures that bike rides and walks are refreshing. You can also paraglide over the Pacific Ocean.

13. RECOMMENDED RESTAURANTS NEAR THE EVENT'S VENUE

a) PESCADOS CAPITALES

Av. Mariscal La Mar 1337, Miraflores 15074

This restaurant is famous for its delicious fish and seafood dishes. The atmosphere is lively and colorful and is an ideal place for a relaxed dinner.

Recommended dish: Jalea mixta de mariscos (Mixed fried seafood dish).

b) CEBICHERÍA LA MAR

Av. Mariscal La Mar 770, Miraflores

This is an iconic place to enjoy fresh and delicious Peruvian ceviche. The atmosphere is informal and cozy.

Recommended dish: Mixed ceviche with fish and seafood.

c) ASTRID Y GASTÓN

Av. Paz Soldán 290, San Isidro

Three-starred Michelin restaurant, it offers a blend of Peruvian and fusion cuisine, with an elegant and cozy atmosphere. The service is exceptional. Advance reservation required.

Recommended Dish: Causa de Cangrejo (a Peruvian dish made of layers of mashed potato and filled with crab) and Lomo Saltado (a Chinese-Peruvian Stir-Fried Beef dish).

d) EL BODEGÓN

Calle Tarapacá 197, Miraflores

A charming restaurant that combines Peru's culinary tradition with a cozy and familiar atmosphere.

Recommended dish: Mixed Ceviche and Lomo Saltado a la Pisco (a Chinese-Peruvian Stir-Fried Beef dish with a Pisco Sauce).

e) ISOLINA

Av. San Martín 101, Barranco

Gastronomic retreat that offers authentic Peruvian food with a homemade touch. Cozy atmosphere and outstanding service.

Recommended dish: Seco de Cordero (a typical Peruvian Lamb stew).

14. RECOMMENDATIONS OF TOURIST PLACES IN LIMA

a) LARCO MUSEUM

1515 Simón Bolívar Avenue, entrance through Navarra 169, Pueblo Libre.

Review: The Larco Museum houses an impressive collection of Peruvian pre-Columbian art in a beautiful colonial mansion. It is a journey through Peru's history.

b) PARQUE DE LA RESERVA (RESERVE PARK) AND CIRCUITO MÁGICO DEL AGUA (MAGICAL WATER CIRCUIT)

Jirón Madre de Dios S/N, Lima

This park has dancing water fountains, and a nighttime light show that makes it a magical place to visit at night.

c) LIMA'S HISTORIC CENTER

Lima's historic center is a World Heritage Site and includes impressive colonial architecture, charming squares and majestic cathedrals.

d) BARRANCO

Barranco is a bohemian, artistic neighborhood which is full of colorful colonial houses, art galleries and a vibrant nightlife.

e) MALECÓN DE MIRAFLORES

Mal. de la Reserva 275, Miraflores

This is an iconic seaside promenade that combines spectacular views of the Pacific Ocean with a vibrant urban atmosphere. It has green spaces and modern facilities and is an ideal place to relax and enjoy the sea breeze.

f) LARCOMAR

Mal. de la Reserva 610, Miraflores

This is a modern seaside shopping mall that offers a wide variety of stores, restaurants and entertainment, all with breathtaking views of the Pacific Ocean. It's a must-see destination for locals and tourists alike.
